Regarding Irregularities in National Scholarship Portal (NSP) under Scholarship Schemes. (CUM.A)

Sir,

In reference to the letter No F.No.13/9/2016-SS dated 16.4.2018 received from the Government of India, Ministry of Minority Affairs, 11th Floor, Pt. Deendayal Antyodaya Bhawan, C.G.O.Complex, Lodhi Road New Delhi-110003 on the subject cited above.

In this context, it is stated, that the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi is implementing the Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme meant for six notified minority communities through NSP portal and since this scheme has been launched on the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) in 2015-16 a number of complaints has been received by the Ministry from many states regarding the registration of fake/ghost beneficiaries on NSP portal and their verification by the Schools/Institutions leading to non-payment of scholarship to the genuine beneficiaries under the scheme. Some fraud cases were reported to State CIDs & many details from NIC Delhi which are maintaining the NSP portal.

In view of the above, you are directed to direct all the BEEOs/Head Masters/ Principals, working under your control to take the following action:-

- a. Advise the Schools/ Institutes to reset their password immediately.
- b. Schools/ Institutes should examine the secrecy of the password protected and changed at regular periodicity as advised by the NIC Delhi
- c. Take utmost precaution while verifying of applications to check the credentials of the school/institutes and the genuineness of the applicants along with their domicile.
- d. Random inspection of schools/institutions can also be made to check the authenticity of the scholarships being disbursed.

Any information about the intended fraudulent activities in this connection should be acted upon District/Block offices without any loss and report may be sent to the Ministry and NIC Delhi.

This may be treated as most immediate and time bound.

**Subject: Re-opening of NSP portal for the verification of un-verified
Renewal applications at State/District level for 2017-18.**

Sir,

I am directed to say that despite keeping open the verification option for applications under Pre-Matric, Post-Matric and Merit cum Means based Scholarship Schemes meant for minorities till 30th November, 2017, on NSP portal for 2017-18, some States/UTs have not completed the verification process within the said time limit due to unforeseen circumstances. Consequently, the scholarship applications for many genuine minority Renewal students have not been verified yet.

2. The matter has been examined in this Ministry and it has been decided with the approval of competent authority to re-open the application verification process for State/District login only for 2017-18 for pending/ un-verified Renewal applications under aforesaid schemes.
3. It is, thus, requested to re-open the NSP Portal for online verification of un-verified/pending 'Renewal' applications for all States/UTs w.e.f. 07.05.2018 till 16.05.2018 under all three schemes, so that such applications may be verified by 'State/District level authority' for the disbursement of scholarships for 2017-18.
4. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
