

Subject: Regarding- Observance of Road Safety Month- 2025.

Madam/ Sir,

This is to inform you that Road Safety is an area of concern in the country as well as in the State of Himachal Pradesh. Every year in the State about 2500 road accidents occur and around 1000 valuable lives are lost in these accidents. This not only leads to human suffering, but also impact the economy adversely.

Therefore, the State Government on the analogy of National Road Safety Month is observing "Road Safety Month" w.e.f 1st January 2025 till 31st January 2025. The Directorate of Transport has prepared a detailed weekly and daily schedule of activities to be carried out at the level of State/ District/ Sub Division/ Block and Urban Local Bodies to disseminate widespread awareness among the public at large especially the young generation on road safety.

This one month campaign will be carried out by all the stakeholder departments including Police, Transport, Health, Public Works Department (HP- PWD), National Highways Authority of India (NHAI), Education, Panchayati Raj, Urban Local Bodies, NGOs etc. The campaign will be carried out under the overall supervision of the Deputy Commissioners who are also head of District Road Safety Committee.

During the "Road Safety Month" the Deputy Commissioners and District Superintendents of Police will institute district wise targets for the road crash reduction in the district to ensure that the road accidents are reduced by 10% as compared to the year 2023 as decided during the "State Level Road Safety Review Meeting- 2024" held under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary to the Govt. of Himachal. District Administration will direct the concerned authorities to immediately correct the "road engineering contributing factors" in road crashes in their districts- such as black spots and vulnerable spots, untreated intersections, lack of school zones, lack of illuminations etc. District Police will launch zero tolerance drive against drinking and driving, over- speeding, Wrong side driving, non- use of safety gears i.e helmets and seat belts etc.



It is also requested to direct the officers at the District level to document all the above mentioned activities and send the report along with the photographs and videos to the O/o of Director Transport via e-mail addressed at rseducation-tpt@hp.gov.in and also upload the proceedings of District Road Safety Committee (DRSC) on the MoRTH website as well as to upload the activities under taken during the road safety month on the MY Bharat Portal so that the same could be brought to the notice of Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety (SCCoRS). The date wise schedule of activities are mentioned at **Annexure- A**.





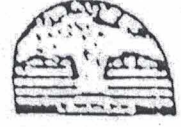
