In reference to the letter No. EDN-H(Ele)B(6)4-26/2022-23(Min) dated 22-07-2022 received from Director Elementary Education Himachal Pradesh Shimla on the subject cited above.

In this context, it is informed you that the online implementation of the Pre-Matric based scholarship schemes (**Pre-Matric Minority Scholarship and Pre-matric Scholarship for students with Disabilities**) shall be done through the **National Scholarship Portal (NSP)** of the Government of India, under URL www.scholarships.gov.in.

The Central Government has decided to open (NSP) Portal from **20th of July, 2022** for the year **2022-23** as per detailed below:-

Opening of Portal	20 th July, 2022
Last Date for application submission by students	20 th September, 2022
Last date for (INO) Institute level verification	30 th September, 2022

It is therefore, all the heads of institution are directed to take further necessary action for filling up the applications form of the students under the scheme and verification of the same in a time bound manner.

Note:- Along with this, the institutions whose heads have not registered their schools on the NSP portal are hereby directed to get their registration and KYC done at the earliest. The nodal officers of the institute are also directed to update their course details on the portal as soon as possible after getting registered. So that their students can apply for the scheme.

For Pre-Matric Scholarship Schemes, Portal will remain opened w.e.f. 20 July, 2022 to 30th of September, 2022. Last date for INO level verification will be 16th of October, 2022 and for Second level verification it will be 31st of October, 2022.

All the Deputy Directors of Elementary Education are hereby directed to take further necessary action in the matter as per the directions contained in the above mentioned letter received from the Ministry of Minority Affairs, well in time, under intimation to this Directorate. All the Principals, Head Masters and concerned subordinate officers may accordingly be directed to take further action for filling up the applications and verifications of the same in a time bound manner.

Annexure-II

Actions to be taken by the State Governments/ UT Administration related to the implementation of the 3 Scholarship Schemes:

- i. All Universities/ Institutions / Colleges/ Schools, having valid AISHE/U-DISE/NCVT/SCVT codes, located in the State/ UT should be advised to register themselves and get their KYC and Aadhaar-Demo-Authentication done at the earliest. They should also be advised to get their courses' details updated on the NSP at the earliest so that their students can apply and they can verify such applications on the Portal within the timelines.
- ii. The timelines need to be adhered to strictly. Technical issue, if any arising during the process of online submissions, verification, generation of merit lists and payment lots may be resolved immediately in consultation with the NIC HQ or State NICs at the earliest.
- iii. It has been observed that after the last date (s) of verification, a large number of Fresh as well as Renewal applications are left pending for verification at L1 level by Institute Nodal Officers and L2 level by State/ District Nodal Officers (SNOs/DNOs). All States / UTs are advised to look into this issue and ensure that no application remains unverified after the stipulated last date (s) of verification during 2022-23.
- iv. All Verification Authorities (INO/ DNO/SNO) are advised to mark an application fake only if he/ she is satisfied that the applicant is not a bonafide student. In other circumstances, in case of non-fulfilment of eligibility criteria or inconsistency of records, the verifying authority may either reject the application or mark it defective and give the applicant another opportunity to correct their records.
- v. It needs to be noted by all the INOs, DNOs and SNOs that in case if any application is marked fake at L2 Level by the DNO or the SNO then the entire bunch of applications from that School/ Institute will go back to the respective INO login of that School/ Institute for re-verification. Hence the DNOs/SNOs are advised to exercise caution while using the option of marking an application fake.
