Intensified Diarrhoea Control Fortnight (IDCF)

...with the goal of "zero" childhood death due to diarrhoea

OBJECTIVE OF IDCF

The overall objective of IDCF is to ensure high coverage of ORS and Zinc use rates in children with diarrhoea throughout the country along with inculcating appropriate behaviour in care givers for diarrhoea prevention & management of under-five children, with emphasis on the high priority areas and vulnerable communities

When: 4th June, 2018- 17th June, 2018

Key Stakeholders: ASHA/ANM in communities, All Health facilities, Anganwadis, Schools, Panchayat Raj Institutions, Tribal Affairs deptt. Functionaries,

CORE ACTIVITIES FOR FORTNIGHT

1. Distribute ORS by ASHA :

- Distribute ORS to under-five children families
- **Demonstrate of ORS preparation**
- Treat diarrhoea cases and refer dehydration cases to health facilities
- Rs 1/- per ORS packet distributed by ASHA is the incentive for this activity

COMMUNITY

2. Establish ORS- Zinc corners :

- Establish ORS- Zinc corners in OPD and Paediatric ward
- Medical College, District Hospital, PHC/CHC, HSC, Private Practitioners
- Paste to display facility appropriate treatment protocols in OPD and ward
- ORS-Zinc corners at Anganwadi centres

3. Demonstrate hand washing in SCHOOLS: Primary and Middle schools

- Paste to display poster on 'steps of hand washing' at H W area
- Deliver message on importance on hand washing at morning assembly/ prayer
- Hand wash with water and soap before mid day meal

CORE ACTIVITIES FOR FORTNIGHT ..CONT...

4. Visit by ANM to villages as per immunization /VHND micro-plan & conduct special session on diarrhoea prevention & management

- Demonstrate preparation of ORS and Zinc
- Tell importance of safe water, hand-washing and appropriate IYCF during diarrhoea
- Provide key messages on rehydration therapy and explain dosages of ORS and Zinc

COMMUNITY

5. Special VHNSC meeting focusing on sanitation

- Map open defecation areas in and surrounding the village and plan for stopping open defecation

6. Intensive Awareness generation

- State and district level launch with the message that *No Child Should Die due to Diarrhoea*
- Posters, banners, hoardings at strategic locations
- Miking and rallies
- Television and Radio

Urban areas

High visibility of activities: Posters, banners, FM radio

Mobile teams for - slums, floating population etc

Establish ORS – Zinc corners in medical colleges, district hospital, Urban Health Post Urban Primary Health Centres

Private pediatricians /medical practitioners through IAP/IMA for setting up of ORS – Zinc corners in their clinics and wards

Urban ASHA, wherever available will work as outlined for ruralASHA

Department of School Education & Literacy, MHRD: –

- ❑ Coordinate with Department of Health and Family Welfare in the effective roll-out of IDCF. Hand washing demonstration and competitions (Drawing, Painting etc.) at schools
- ❑ Dissemination of IEC material to all schools, including community mobilization through School Management Committees
- ❑ Each school can have poster pasted at the hand washing area on steps for effective hand washing. **MHRD may provide support for the budget**
- ❑ After the morning assembly prayers, message on importance of hand washing can be delivered to all the students.
- ❑ Before mid-day meal, all children can be taught to wash hands following the steps in the poster with water and soap.
- ❑ Focus on “Aspirational Districts Initiative” on Toilet access for girls and availability of drinking water - which overlaps with efforts for IDCF activities.

Ministry of Women and Child Development:-

- ❑ Establish ORS and Zinc corners in AWCs in coordination with ASHAs and ANMs.
- ❑ IDCF to be kept as topic of discussion in VHND sessions during IDCF
- ❑ Ensure community mobilization, especially of non-enrolled children through Anganwadi Workers — Coordinate with Department of Health and Family Welfare in effective roll-out of IDCF.
- ❑ Using the platform of monthly meetings to be held before the IDCF campaign to orient lady supervisors and Anganwadi workers (AWWs) focusing on Diarrhoea control and use of ORS. Necessary direction to States

Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation:-

- ❑ Seeking IEC material on safe drinking water from the Ministry to be used during IDCF campaign. This material will be shared with the States.
- ❑ Taking up awareness generation and development communication activities related to safe drinking water during IDCF period among Gram Panchayat Water & Sanitation Committee members and the village community through Block Resource Centre.
- ❑ **There is a provision of providing incentives to ASHA Workers who motivate households to obtain tap connections within their houses @Rs.75 per connection.** This activity can be aligned with IDCF. The funds will be provided from the National Rural Drinking Water and Sanitation program.
- ❑ Implementing demonstration of handwashing in Schools through Drinking water and Sanitation budget
- ❑ To take an account of provision for safe drinking water in schools and AWCs in Aspirational districts.

Ministry of Panchayati Raj:-

1. Post Development meetings/Gram Sabha focusing on Diarrhoea control and use of ORS & Zinc to be arranged during this period. Block Medical officer can facilitate discussions at such meetings

2. Co-ordinate in ORS corners in AWCs and dissemination of key messages

3. To participate of members of PRI at village, block and district level meeting for social for advocacy and awareness generation.

Current Challenges in diarrhoea management

1. Low coverage in socio-economically marginalized communities
 - With a hygienic and poor sanitation environment

2. High rate of open defecation and poor hand washing practices

3. 5% of children are malnourished, i.e. at increased risk of death

4. Low availability and use of ORS and Zinc - only 54.4% children with diarrhoea receive ORS, and only 20.3% were given both ORS and Zinc (NFHS-4)
