

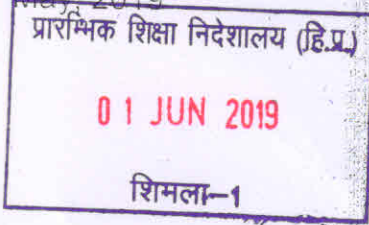



Dear Chief Secretary,

As you are aware, reduction of childhood mortality is one of the prime goals of National and State Governments. Childhood diarrhoeal disease continues to be a major killer among under-five children in many states, contributing to about 10% of under-five deaths in the country. Almost all the deaths due to diarrhoea can be averted by preventing and treating dehydration by the use of ORS (Oral Rehydration Solution) and administration of Zinc tablets along with adequate nutritional intake by the child during diarrhoea.

To effectively address this issue, Intensified Diarrhoea Control Fortnight (IDCF) is being implemented for the last five years, reaching out to millions of children, with the ultimate aim of zero child deaths due to childhood diarrhoea. In 2019, also, it has been decided to implement IDCF from 28th May to 8th June to intensify efforts towards reducing deaths due to diarrhoea among under-5 children. During IDCF, several activities will be carried out which includes intensification of advocacy and awareness generation activities for diarrhoea management, strengthening service provision for diarrhoea case management, establishment of ORS-Zinc corners, distribution of ORS by ASHA to households with under-five children and awareness generation activities for sanitation and hygiene.

The following steps are suggested for effective coverage of targeted children with ORS and Zinc during Intensified Diarrhoea Control Fortnight:


1. All the key stakeholder departments at the State level to coordinate with Department of Health in effective rolling out of IDCF.
2. All departments need to put IDCF as one of the agenda in their periodic or monthly meetings to reinforce key messages for the program and facilitate high coverage.
3. States to issue similar joint directive to the districts for an effective roll-out of IDCF 2019 rounds.

The specific activities to be undertaken by the concerned departments are enclosed.

We request you to inform all concerned departments to join hands for success of this campaign to prevent avoidable deaths due to diarrhoea. We also request you to write to all District Magistrates/Collectors in the State to take a lead in implementing IDCF and ensuring inter-departmental convergence for IDCF at district level. We look forward to your support and cooperation for successful implementation of the programme.






