Subject: Regarding recent increase in COVID 19 Cases in the neighboring States

Madam/Sir,

It has been observed that in the last few days, COVID 19 Positive cases increased on daily basis in the neighboring states in view of this surge in the cases the following actions need to be taken immediacy to contain the spread of infection in the community.


- 1. COVID 19 Testing:** It has come to notice that the COVID 19 testing in the state has recently declined on regular basis and the proportion of RTPCR testing has also drastically fallen Therefore it is directed to ensure that the overall testing is immediately enhanced as well as also directed to scale up the RT-PCR testing in your respective district to stop the further transmission of Infection. Also ensure increase in COVID 19 testing in Border areas (District Solan , Sirmour , Una , Kangra, Chamba) & Tourist Hotspots (Shimla , Dharamshala , Kullu , Manali , Chamba , Lahaul & Spiti & Kinnaur).
- 2. Revised Surveillance Strategy :** Revised Surveillance Strategy should be immediately adopted, all the SARI cases reported to healthcare facility as well as indoor patients should be tested through RT-PCR only , there should be close watch on ILI & SARI cases reported.
- 3. Whole Genomic sequencing :** Ensure Samples of positive reported COVID-19 Hospitalized cases to be send for whole genomic sequencing to INSACOG lab on weekly basis
- 4. Contact Tracing :** In order to avoid the exponential increase in the COVID -19 cases in the state the Contact tracing needs to be ensured .20 contacts or more of each positive case should be traced within 48 hours and all high risk contacts should be tested as per protocol

5. **COVID Facilities** : All the COVID Healthcare facilities/Hospitals (DCHCs & DCH) needs to be reviewed to provide adequate treatment facilities to the symptomatic positive patients.

6. **COVID appropriate Behavior**: COVID appropriate Behavior is the need of the hour, it is emphasized that there is a need to exercise abundant caution by adopting covid appropriate behavior by every citizen in their daily routine. As it has been observed that people are ignoring the cardinal safety requirements such as wearing masks and maintain physical distancing in various gatherings & public places such behavior poses a serious threat to public health. Therefore urgent need to instill a sense of discipline and ownership among citizens in order that the resumption of activities is successful & gains made in management of the pandemic are not diluted. It is required to promote COVID-19 appropriate behavior extensively at the grass root level. Districts shall closely monitor the case trajectories across all districts on a daily basis to identify any early warning signals and shall ensured adherence to COVID appropriate Behaviour to control the spread of infection.

7. **Educational Institutions**: The COVID appropriate Behavior in education institutional in your respective District should be mandatory. It shall be ensured by the school that students wear mask properly, observe physical distancing and follow hand & sanitary hygiene . The Class teacher should be alert to any child with signs and symptoms. Teacher, School staff and students should also be advised about simple public health measures of hand and respiratory hygiene.
