Regarding National Scholarship Portal (NSP) was launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister on 1st July 2015 as a key initiative under Digital India programme..

Sir,

In reference to the DO letter No.8-3/2019-SS dated 05.07.2019 received from Sh. Sailesh, Secretary, to the Government of India, Ministry of Minority Affairs 11th Floor, Pt. Deendayal Antyodya Bhawan, CGO complex, Lodhi Road New Delhi on the subject cited above.

In this context as you are well aware that the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) was launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister on 1st July 2015 as a key initiative under Digital India Programme aimed at providing one-stop solution for scholarships. It facilitates a gamut of activities ranging from student registration to application submission, verification, national level de-duplication, merit list generation, sanction and electronic transfer of funds; thereby providing an end-to-end comprehensive solution towards enabling effective disbursement of scholarships.

2. In the Academic year (AY) 2018-19, 60 scholarship Schemes (pertaining to 10 Ministries/departments of GOI and 9 States) were on-boarded on NSP and more than Rs.2100 crore scholarship amount has been disbursed to around 68 lakh students till date. During A.Y 2018-19, the Pre-Matric Scholarship Schemes of this Ministry had on-boarded on NSP.

3. I would like to bring to your kind notice that during A.Y 2018-19, there were repeated attempts to subvert the system/NSP, especially at the verification stage of the scholarship applications. After brainstorming and discussions. It has been agreed by all the Scholarship running Ministries/Departments, that the verifying authorities (Schools, Institutes, District Nodal Officer, etc.) are the most critical stakeholders who ensure integrity of the verification process. Due to legacy data received from earlier system, it is quite possible that many inconsistent entries are present in the System/ NSP, thus leading to infirmities in the database. Keeping in view the recent attempts to subvert the system, it has been unanimously decided that a one-time cleaning of Institute/Schools database in NSP must be undertaken.

4. In this regard the following action have been initiated /decided:

(i) All Institutes/Schools that do not have valid AISHE/DISE codes have been deregistered A provision has been made for their re-registration after obtaining valid AISHE/DISE code.

(ii) Email ids and mobile numbers of all Institutes/Schools registered /stored in NSP have been deactivated. District Nodal officers, as the case may be, will verify credentials of the Institute/School Nodal Officer and reset his/her password through a well-defined procedure, wherein, the Institute /School nodal officer will fill up an online form on the portal and get the printout authenticated in Duplicate with his/her Head of the Institute/School and submit it to the District Nodal officer. 
(iii) District Nodal officer will retain a copy of duly authenticated online form, received from Institutes /School, and return the second copy to the Institute/School for their respective records. It will be the responsibility of the Institute/School to retain the copy received from District and produce it to the appropriate authority on demand.

(iv) The Cooperation of District/Institutes is solicited in the matter for timely Completion of task.

5. It is imperative that the actions mentioned in Para 4 must be expedited and completed by the respective Districts as soon as possible. Any delay on part of the institute/School or the District Nodal Authority will hamper the prospect of the applicants associated to the respective Institute/School, in receiving the Scholarships.

6. It is therefore, requested you to widely disseminate the information pertaining to the actions to be undertaken by the Institutes/Schools and District Nodal authorities to facilitate timely processing and disbursement of Scholarships to the applicants.

This may be treated as most immediate and time bound please.

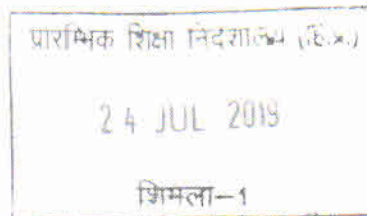



Subject: - Regarding Timeline Activities under Pre-Matric Scholarship Schemes for minority communities/Disabilities for the year 2019-20.

Sir,

In reference to the letter No.8-4/2019-SS dated 17.07.2019 received from Sh. Niva Singh, Joint Secretary, to the Government of India, Ministry of Minority Affairs 11th Floor, Pt. Deendayal Antyodya Bhawan, CGO complex, Lodhi Road New Delhi, it is to inform you that the Ministry of Minority Affairs, and Department of empowerment of persons Disabilities Government of India, New Delhi has opened a Portal NSP for receipt of online application from students under Pre-Matric Minority Community for fresh/Renewal and Disabilities Scholarship Scheme w.e.f. 15th July to 15th October, 2019.

You are therefore requested to bring the above instructions of GOI to the notice of all the head of institutions working under your control for giving wide publicity be ensured by way of information in the morning assembly, by displaying a notice in this regard on the school notice board, on the Panchayat and Mahila Mandal office's notice boards so that all the eligible students could avail the benefit of this scholarship scheme. This may also be announced daily in the morning assembly that the bank accounts of the students "applying for the aforesaid scholarship must be linked with their Aadhaar number" so that their scholarship could easily be released in their bank account through DBT mode. From the year 2016-17 the National Scholarship Portal is accepting only online application and no offline application will be accepted.

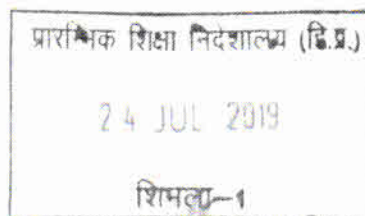
In view of the above all efforts may be made to adhere to the aforesaid timelines given on the portal and resolve any technical issue that may crop up in the process of online submission generation of merit lists and payment lots by coordinating with state NICs at the earliest.
