(To frame a foolproof mechanism for implementation of commission for protection of Child Right Act, 2005, RTE Act, 2009 and to keep a vigil and check over private educational Institutions etc.)

Sir,

In continuation to this Directorate letter of even no. dated 06-04-2016, 19-08-2016, 30-11-2016, 25-02-2017 and 31-05-2017 vide which it was conveyed that the subject cited petition was filed before the Hon'ble High Court of HP seeking relief (S) to direct the respondents to frame a foolproof mechanism for the implementation of the Commission for Protection of Child Right Act, 2005 as well as Right of Children to free and Compulsory Education act, 2009 and to implement the direction issued by the Respondent No.5 i.e. National Commission for Protection of Child Rights, Government of India in this behalf and to keep a vigil and check over these privately run institutions so that they may not violate the law frequently.

Reply to the petition was filed comprising therein that, the Govt. of H.P. has already constituted the Right to Education Protection Authorities in the state and the Respondent-State direct the field offices to ensure ban on corporal punishment/restore dignity of children in private schools under RTE Act from time to time.

You are therefor requested to ensure ban on corporal punishment/mental harassment to a child restore dignity of children in private school under RTE Act. If any teacher/school is found to be indulge in any to the following unfair practices viz physical punishment, mental harassment eve teasing sexual harassment, derogatory remarks verbal as well as in writing, discrimination during Mid-day-Meal on the ground of religion cast, creed sex, place of birth or any of them, denial admission for lack of age proof or on the ground having HIV/AIDS or any other serious ailment or on the ground of disability then such matters may be inquired into immediately in a time bound manner and to take action against the delinquent/defaultter teacher/school on the basis of the finding of the inquiry report as well as per provision of RTE Act/Rules and send compliance report immediately to this Directorate.
