Time line activities under the Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme for students belonging to the notified minority communities for the year 2016-17.

Sir,

In continuation of this Directorate letter No even dated 23.4.2016 you are well aware that the Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme is a centrally Sponsored Scheme launched in the year 2008 to award scholarships to the students for studies in india in a Government or Private schools from classes 1st to 10th from the notified minority communities (i.e. **Muslim, Christians, Sikh, Budhist and Parsi**) who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/ guardian from all sources do not exceed Rs 1.00 lakh. From 2014-15 Pre-Matric Scholarship scheme is a Central Sector Scheme with 100% Central funding. The Pre-Matric scholarship Scheme, the scheme is required to be announced well in time in the daily Morning Assembly/displaying a notice in this regard on the school notice board or any notice board fixed in the public domain/ panchayat office/ Mahila Mandal office etc. The time line activities to be performed by all the Deputy Director of Elementary Education/ Higher Education in the state as direction given by the Government of India.

Specimen format of application should be filled up by the students for providing details of students recommended for award of scholarship .It is pertinent to mention here that the application format to be used by the students under this scheme is also available on the website of Elementary Education Department (<http://himachal.nic.in/eleedu/>). Students studying in classes IX -X will have the option to apply online in the dedicated web portal of e-national scholarship being developed by the National Scholarship Portal , Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India when the date will be fixed for submission of online forms by the Government of India. Students in classes 1st to 8th off line may use the bank account of their parents (preferably mother) or a bank account opened under Prime Minister's Jan Dhan Yojna. However the students of classes IX & X should have a bank account in their name in any of the nationalized bank and Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India has not fixed any date of submission the offline forms till date until the date is not fixed by the Government of India .You are requested only to collect the forms at Block Elementry Education offices.

You are therefore requested to give wide publicity to the scheme so that the minority communities students are able to avail maximum benefit of this scholarship scheme and submit the consolidated list of eligible students on the prescribed proforma (**both hard and soft copy in excel sheet**) in accordance when the Government of India will give the direction for submission the forms..

This may b treated as most urgent and time bound please.
