OFFICE ORDER

In pursuance and compliance to the approval conveyed by the Government vide letter No PER(AP)-C-B(2)-2/2015 dated 22.04.2016 and based on verification by the B.E.E.O concerned and recommendations of the screening committee constituted at the Dy. Director of Elementary Education level, the following JBT Teachers who were appointed purely on contract basis and posted in GPS in this distt, against sanctioned vacant posts as per R&P Rules for the post at initial recruitment on contract basis and who have completed five year services as on 31.03.2016, are hereby regularized as JBT teachers in the pay band of Rs 5910-20200 plus grade pay 3000/- initial start of Rs 5910+3000 GP/- plus other allowances as admissible from time to time with immediate effect :-

The above regularizations subject to the fulfillment of requisite terms and conditions as under :-

1. All the controlling officers/DDOs/B.E.E.O.s are directed to verify all the certificate produced by the candidate concerned from the respective boards/universities on priority basis and necessary entries to this effect be recorded in the service of the JBT teachers. Any lapse in this regard shall be viewed seriously and would be the personal responsibility of the controlling officer (s).
2. The services of above contract JBT teachers have been regularized as JBT as they have put in five years service as on 31.03.2016. Period of absence has not be counted towards length of service however, period of un-authorized absence on medical grounds has not been treated as break in service. Before accepting the joining, concerned DDO/B.E.E.Os are directed to ensure that no departmental enquiry/vigilance case is pending against the teacher whose services has been being regularized. If in any case, it comes to the notice of the authorities at a later stage, then the matter may be brought to the notice of the Department for immediate necessary action.
3. The seniority of the contract teacher so regularized shall be on the basis of his/her merit in the selection list.

The benefits of regularization are subject to the following terms and conditions :-

- I) The post is temporary but likely to be continued and the teacher concerned will be on probation for two years which can be extended for another one year if he/she does not satisfactorily completes the probation period keeping in-view the work and conduct of the official.
- II) Prior to granting benefits of regularization every regularized teacher shall have to submit the following documents/undertaking to their controlling/DDO :-
 - (i) That the regularized JBT teacher should be medically fit for the post being considered for Medical Officer/Medical Officer of the Illaqua/area concerned at the time of his/her joining. The regularization shall be subject to the verification of character and antecedents of the candidate by the Head of the Institution.
 - (ii) The regularized contract JBT teacher shall be liable to be posted anywhere in the Distt.
 - (iii) The regularized contract JBT teacher shall have submit a declaration to the effect that if married, he/she has only one spouse living. The women teacher will declare that she has not married to a person having another living wife.
 - (iv) The regularized contract JBT teacher will have to make an Oath of allegiance/faithfulness to the Constitution of India.
 - (v) The regularized contract JBT teacher belonging to SC/ST/OBC category etc. will furnish the parental certificate on the prescribed format issued by the competent authority.
 - (vi) In case, the credential of the candidate and any of the certificate/documents produced by him/her are found false/wrong, at any stage, his/her service are liable to be terminated.
 - (vii) The regularized contract JBT teacher shall have to serve in the difficult area for a minimum period of five years.
 - (viii) That candidate who is being regularized as JBT will have to ensure that he/she has acquired complete knowledge of the latest CCS/conduct rules within a fortnight and submit a undertaking to this effect in writing to his/her head of office/school.
 - (ix) The concerned candidate shall have to produce attested copies of hi/her academic/professional qualification/domicile/date of birth certificates etc.
 - (x) The concerned candidate shall furnish a declaration to the effect that she is not a dismissed employee of any Govt/Semi Govt. Department/Organisation. She will have give in writing whether she was ever convicted by the competent court of law and if so, the particulars of the offence and punishment be stated. Failing to disclose the facts, he/she will render his/her self liable to be removed from service without

any notice as and when the factual facts come to light. The candidate concerned shall have to produce the certificate of his/her citizen of India.

- (xi) The candidate shall have to produce the bonafide Himachali certificate issued by the competent authority.
