**Subject: Legal Literacy programme in Schools and Colleges.**

I have the honour to refer to this Authority letter dated 10.3.2016 and 9.5.2016 and the decision taken in 12<sup>th</sup> All India Meet of the State Legal Services Authorities held at Lucknow on 8-9<sup>th</sup> March, 2014 that Fundamental Duties shall be the focus of all Legal Literacy Camps in Schools. National Legal Services Authority has also directed to continue teaching on Fundamental Duties to the students of the School and Colleges. You are also aware that as many as 11242 teachers were identified and training on Fundamental Duties were imparted to them by District Legal Services Authorities and Sub Divisional Legal Services Committees. However, on perusal of the information sent to this Authority, it has been observed that "Lessons in Law" and Fundamental Duties are not being taught regularly in schools and colleges and there is no information of Fundamental Duties being taught to students by trained teachers.

We may again reiterate that we have undertaken various correspondences with your Authority/Committee, emphasizing to continue with old practice of Legal Literacy Campaign in Schools/Colleges by teaching Lessons in Law and Fundamental Duties.


