Implementation of provisions of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection) of Children Act, 2015-reg.

With reference to the letter D.O. No. 2801/07/2016-Media/NCPCR/Vol.II/58003 dated 12th July, 2017 received from the Chairperson, Government of India, National Commission for Protection of Child Rights, New Delhi-110001 through the Addl. Chief Secretary (Education) to the Government of Himachal Pradesh vide his letter No. EDN-C-F(10)-5/2016- dated 27/07/2017 on the subject cited above

In this context, it is submitted that NCPCR a statutory body has established under the Commission for Protection of Child Rights (CPCR) Act, 2005, is mandated for monitoring the implementation of provisions of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015. The commission has taken a soumotu cognizance of and incident published in the Times of India on 7th July, 2017 Hyderabad worries as drug racket networks students'. As per newspaper Director (Enforcement), Hyderabad stated that the peddlers used WhatsApp to route drugs. The students of top 25 premier schools and 20 top colleges were customers of this gang was selling LS (Lysegic acid diethylamide), commonly called acid and MDMA (methylene-dioxymethamphetamine). The students are being misused by drug rackets.

The Juvenile Justice Act, 2015 contains provisions under section 78 prohibits issuing a child for vending, peddling, carrying, supplying or smuggling and intoxication liquor, narcotic drug or psychotropic substance while section 77 states the severe punishment attached for misuse of children for these purposes.

In view of the above you are therefore requested to issue this instructions to all the BEEOs/Principals/Headmasters under your control to ensure effective implementation of the Juvenile Justice Act and Action Taken Report may be submitted to the GOI.

This may be treated as most urgent and time bound.
