Subject: - Implementation of "The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (Amendment) Act, 2019". Regarding conducting 5th and 8th class examination.

Sir,

Refer to this Directorate's letter of even number, dated 03-09-2019 (copy enclosed for your ready reference), on the subject cited above, vide which copy of the policy guidelines approved by the Government vide letter No: EDN-C-A(3)-2/2028, dated 02-09-2019 on the subject cited above.

The said guidelines contain clear directions regarding process of conducting examination of class 5th and 8th, evaluation of answer sheets, detention of students and re-appear examination of such students who could not perform well. But it has been observed that the instructions/ guidelines are not being followed as a result of which no student has been reports to have been detained in either of the two classes mentioned above since long.

It is, therefore, re-iterated that following directions clearly contained in the guidelines issued by the Govt. on dated 02-09-2019 circulated by the Directorate of Elementary Education vide its letter No.EDN-H(Ele)(4)4/2015-19(Exam) be followed and complied with in letter and spirit forthwith:

1. The answer sheets of 5th class will be evaluated under the control of BEEO concerned and answer sheets of 8th class will be evaluated under the control of BPO-cum-Principal of the cluster concerned.
2. The examiner will not get the answer sheets of the students he had taught.
3. In case of students securing less than 33% marks, he/she shall be given additional instruction, through remedial classes/ online guidance, and granted opportunity for re-examination within the next two months until then he/she will continue sitting in the same class. If student still fails in the re-examination he/she will be detained in the same class by the school.
4. Re-appear examination will be conducted only of the subject in which the student has failed.

It is further directed that every Block Elementary Education Officer would specifically report at the completion of academic session as to how many students have been detained in their Block class wise. The instructions be adhered to strictly under intimation to this Directorate.
