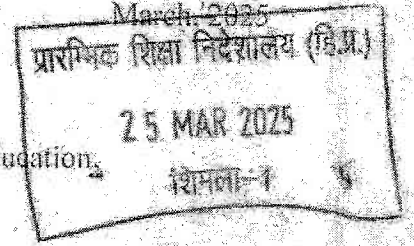

In alignment with the objectives of the Jal Evam Jalvayu Sanrakshan program, all government schools(GMS,GHS,GSSS) in the districts are directed to organize awareness and conservation activities focusing on water and climate protection. These activities aim to instill a sense of environmental responsibility among students and promote sustainable practices.

**Activities to be Conducted:**

**1. Water Testing in Schools :**

Purity of water will be tested in labs of the schools thrice in a year. Water testing kits /field testing kits will be provided by Jal Shakti Vibhag as Samagra Shiksha Himachal Pradesh has signed MoU with them for providing kits and training of preferably Maths/Science teachers. Principal of the school will issue the report of the purity. The report will be given to the Jal Shakti Vibhag and the copy will also be given to Sub Divisional Magistrate of the respective areas.

**2. Celebration of Jal Utsav:**

Jal Utsav will be celebrated in government schools in coordination with community twice a year. PRIs, Block Development Officers, SDMs and Health workers will take part in the event. Organize competitions such as poster making, essay writing or debate contests focused on water conservation topics. This event will be used as platforms to showcase creative ideas and solutions for water conservation.

**3. Study about Water sources:**

Group of volunteers from schools including students and teachers will study about the water sources of the area and will work on the areas about increasing and conservation.

of the water sources. This group of volunteers will collaborate with local environmental organizations or water conservation groups for joint initiatives and projects. This group will engage in community outreach programs related to water conservation, such as organising awareness events or participating in clean-up drives.

#### **4. Some Other Activities:**

- Morning Assembly Talk – Special talks by teachers and students on the significance of water conservation.
- Guest Lectures – Experts from NGOs or government departments speak about water scarcity and conservation.
- Documentary Screening – Showing short films on water conservation, rain water harvesting, and pollution.
- Poster Making, Slogan Writing – Students create posters and slogans promoting water conservation.
- Essay & Poem Writing Competition – Encourages students to express their thoughts on water issues.
- Quiz Competition – Questions related to water sources, conservation methods, and global water challenges.

#### **5. Practical Learning Activities**

- Water Audit in School – Students analyse water usage in their school and suggest ways to reduce wastage.
- Plantation Drive – Planting trees to increase groundwater levels and prevent soil erosion.
- Vertical Gardens: Creating small vertical gardens using recycled materials.

#### **6. Community Involvement Activities**

- Rally on Water Conservation – Students participate in a rally with placards and slogans to spread awareness.
- Nukkad Natak (Street Play) – Performing skits on water conservation in schools and nearby areas.
- Water Pledge – Students and teachers take a pledge to use water wisely.

#### **7. Hands-on Initiatives**

- Cleaning of Nearby Natural resources – Organizing cleanliness drives at ponds, lakes, or rivers.
- Fixing Leaks in Schools – Identifying and fixing leaking taps in the school premises.
- Water-Saving Challenge – Encouraging students to monitor and their water usage wisely at home.

These activities make Jal Parv both educational and enjoyable, inspiring young minds to become responsible citizens in conserving water.

#### **8. Waste Management nearby water resources**

- Composting: Setting up compost pits for biodegradable waste.
- Plastic-Free Campus: Banning single-use plastics and promoting eco-friendly alternatives.


#### **9. Reporting & Documentation:**

- Schools must capture photos and videos of the activities and submit an Action Taken Report (ATR) to the DIET cum District Project Office.
- The Nodal Officer for this project will be the coordinators who are already managing the Youth and Eco Clubs in districts.
- All reports, along with multimedia evidence, should be submitted well on time.


