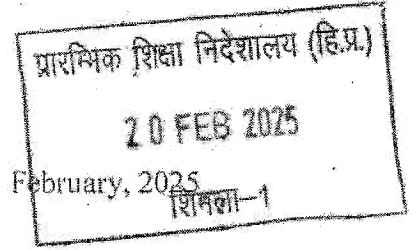



विषय : अन्तर्राष्ट्रीय मातृभाषा दिवस- 21 फरवरी, 2025 (शुक्रवार) के आयोजन के संदर्भ में अनुशांसा।

यूनेस्को के निर्णय के अनुसार प्रत्येक वर्ष 21 फरवरी को अन्तर्राष्ट्रीय मातृभाषा दिवस मनाया जाता है। इस वर्ष इसके आयोजन के संदर्भ में भारतीय भाषा समिति की ओर से निम्नलिखित अनुशासन प्रस्तुत है:

- शैक्षिक परिवेश को ध्यान में रखते हुए स्कूली शिक्षा एवं उच्च शिक्षा में इसे अलग-अलग प्रकार से मना सकते हैं।
- स्कूली शिक्षा विभाग द्वारा पूरे देश के विद्यालयों में अभिभावकों का कार्यक्रम रखा जा सकता है जहाँ मातृभाषा माध्यम में शिक्षा की चर्चा हो, बच्चों की मातृभाषा में अभिव्यक्ति क्षमता बढ़ाने की चर्चा हो, घर में बच्चों के साथ मातृभाषा में व्यवहार का आग्रह हो, मातृभाषा में पढ़ने पढ़े, अन्यान्य भारतीय भाषाओं के लिपियों का विशेषतः मातृभाषा की लिपि का अधिकाधिक अभ्यास एवं प्रयोग को इत्यादि विचारों पर चर्चा हो सकती है।
- उच्च शिक्षा विभाग के द्वारा पूरे देश के महाविद्यालयों एवं विश्वविद्यालयों के हर संकायों/विभाग में प्राध्यापकों एवं छात्रों के बीच कार्यक्रम हो सकते हैं जहाँ मातृभाषाओं को अकांक्षा (Aspirational) की भाषा बनाने के उपायों के बारे में एवं बहुभाषिकता (Multilingualism) के क्रियान्वयन के बारे में परिचर्चा हावी सकती है।
- प्रचार वाक्य (Tag line) इस प्रकार हो सकता है: "मातृभाषा से प्रतिभा एवं क्षमता विकास"
- उच्च शिक्षा विभाग के द्वारा दिल्ली में एक केन्द्रीय कार्यक्रम किया जा सकता है। इसका दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय अथवा आईआईटी-दिल्ली द्वारा कराया जा सकता है। विकल्प के तौर पर, देश के अन्य किसी प्रतिष्ठित संस्थान में भी किया जा सकता है।
