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





Dear Sir/Madam,

Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) in coordination with Ministry of Education (MoE) implements Rashtriya Bal Swasthaya Karyakram (RBSK) in all States/UTs for schools going children. Under this program all children of age group 6-18years in Government and Government aided schools are screened with the objective of early identification and management for 32 selected health conditions - 4 D's i.e. Defects at Birth, Developmental delays, Diseases and Deficiencies.

The RBSK - Mobile Health Teams (MHTs) visit schools annually in their respective blocks as per their scheduled plan for screening school children. The Identified children are further referred to the nearest Public Health facility or District Early Intervention Center (DEIC) for further management and referral. There is a need for strong convergence between both the ministries at every level - State, District and block to reap the maximum benefits of RBSK program. The possible areas needing attention emerged after deliberations with the States/UTs during National Consultative Meeting to strengthen health services for school going children and adolescents are listed below:

1. RBSK - Mobile Health Teams (MHTs)

- Prior information to school authorities regarding their scheduled visits for screening
- Sharing line list of children identified for any health condition under RBSK with Principal, School health and wellness ambassadors or teachers for follow up and compliance.


2. School authorities


- School health and wellness ambassadors or teachers to ensure the 100% attendance of students on the day of screening.
- Proactive involvement of teachers/school health and wellness ambassadors in felicitating RBSK screening

Contd.-2-

- School health and wellness ambassador/teachers actively participating in follow up of identified children.
- Sharing the line list of students missed out during RBSK screening to MHTs for further planning.

Thus, it is requested to take appropriate measures to strengthen the health screening and coverage in schools in your respective State/UT.
